The jurisdiction encompasses the communities of Blackfalds, Tees, Clive, Joffre, Haynes, Gull Lake, Gasoline Alley, and Springbrook.

February 24th, 2026 to March 2nd, 2026

News

The Blackfalds RCMP Detachment received 135 calls for service during the week of February 24th, 2026, to March 2nd, 2026. These calls included 2 Assaults, 1 Being Unlawfully at Large, 1 Breach of Peace, 2 Break and Enters, 3 Disobeying Order of the Court, 1 Disturbing the Peace, 4 Frauds, 2 Harassing Communications, 1 Mischief, 1 Impaired Operation of a Motor Vehicle, 2 Thefts, 4 Theft of Motor Vehicle, and 28 Motor Vehicle Collisions.

February 24, 2026

- Police are investigating the complaint of a Breach of Restraining Order that has been occurring in Red Deer County.
- A call was received of a dispute at a motel in Gasoline Alley. Police attended and mediated the situation. One individual was advised to leave the property.

February 25, 2026

- It was reported that copper wire had been stolen from an oil field site in Lacombe County.

- A motel in Gasoline Alley requested assistance with an unwanted female who was refusing to leave the property. Police attended and transported the female to another location.

February 26, 2026

- It was reported that vehicle had been bought using an individual's personal information and they had not made the purchase. The matter is under investigation.
- Due to icy road conditions throughout the week multiple motor vehicle collisions were reported.

February 27, 2026

- One male was arrested and charged for Assault and Mischief Under \$5000 that occurred in Blackfalds. A JIR hearing was conducted, and he was later released on a Court Order with conditions.
- EMS requested Police assistance in clearing a residence prior to their arrival in Blackfalds for an injured male. Members attended and provided first aid until EMS arrived and then EMS transported the male to the hospital.

February 28, 2026

- Police were called to check on an unresponsive male outside of a business in Red Deer County. It appeared the male was either intoxicated by alcohol or drugs. He was arrested, transported to cells, and later released once sober.
- A motel in Gasoline Alley requested assistance in having a male removed from the property who was sleeping near the lobby. Police attended and the male agreed to leave the property without issue.

March 1, 2026

- Police are investigating the complaint of ongoing harassment that has been occurring at a business in Blackfalds.
- It was reported that a vehicle had been broken into and items stolen sometime overnight while parked outside of a residence in Blackfalds.

March 2, 2026

- A 911 call was received of a single vehicle rollover in Red Deer County. Police and EMS attended. The driver was transported to the hospital by EMS for minor injuries.
- It was reported that a vehicle had been stolen out of Calgary and was being tracked around Red Deer County. Police were able to locate the vehicle which was unoccupied. It was towed and the owner was notified that it had been recovered.
