The jurisdiction encompasses the communities of Blackfalds, Tees, Clive, Joffre, Haynes, Gull Lake, Gasoline Alley, and Springbrook.

March 3rd, 2026 to March 9th, 2026

News

The Blackfalds RCMP Detachment received 83 calls for service during the week of March 3rd, 2026, to March 9th, 2026. These calls included 3 Assaults, 1 Breach of Peace, 1 Criminal Harassment, 2 Dangerous Driving, 1 Disturbing the Peace, 3 Frauds, 1 Identity Theft, 3 Mischiefs, 1 Resist/Obstruct Peace Officer, 1 Robbery with a Firearm, 4 Thefts, and 11 Motor Vehicle Collisions.

March 3, 2026

- Police assisted EMS with an intoxicated and uncooperative female at a residence in Lacombe County.
- A call was received of a disturbance at a residence in Lacombe County. Police attended and mediated the situation. One individual was removed from the property for the rest of the night.

March 4, 2026

- Police attended the call of an erratic driver on the highway in Lacombe County. It was determined both the driver and complainant were at fault. A warning was given to both.
- A dispute was reported at a residence in Blackfalds. Police attended and one of the individuals involved agreed to leave the property.

March 5, 2026

- A business in Red Deer County reported a former employee was attempting to access a work site. Police attended and located the individual who agreed to leave the property.
- Multiple calls were received that vehicles had been broken into and items were stolen in Red Deer County.

March 6, 2026

- Police and Fire attended the call that two semis were on fire at a business in Red Deer County. It was determined one of the semis had been plugged in overnight and the engine compartment caught on fire.
- A business in Blackfalds reported that they had been robbed with a firearm and then the suspects fled. The matter is under investigation.
- One male was arrested and charged for Aggravated Assault and Failure to Comply with Release Order Conditions in Red Deer County.

March 7, 2026

- One female was charged for Mischief – Damage to Property that occurred in Blackfalds.
- An oil site in Lacombe County reported that copper wire had been stolen sometime overnight.

March 8, 2026

- Police are investigating the complaint that an individual had sent e-transfers to a fraudulent business in Blackfalds.
- A business in Red Deer County reported that a female had been dropped off in their parking lot and was acting erratic. Police attended as the female was being picked up by another individual. There were no further concerns.

March 9, 2026

- Police located one male who had an outstanding warrant in Red Deer County. The male resisted arrest so he was subsequently charged and transported to cells where a JIR hearing was conducted.
- It was reported that an individual had been assaulted in Red Deer County. The matter is under investigation.
