June 2nd, 2026 to June 8th, 2026

News

The Blackfalds RCMP Detachment received 170 calls for service during the week of June 2nd, 2026, to June 8th, 2026. These calls included 1 Arson to Motor Vehicle, 2 Assaults, 7 Breach of Peace, 4 Break and Enters, 2 Disturbing the Peace, 1 Harassing Communications, 12 Mischiefs, 2 Operation of a Motor Vehicle while Impaired, 5 Thefts, 1 Theft of Motor Vehicle, 5 Suspicious Persons, 2 Uttering Threats, 8 Wellbeing Checks, and 6 Motor Vehicle Collisions.

June 2, 2026

- It was reported that two vehicles had their fuel tanks drilled out while parked at a construction site in Red Deer County.
- A wellbeing check was requested on an individual who had not been heard from in a week. Police attended the residence and determined the individual was safe and well. The complainant was updated.

June 3, 2026

- Police attended the call that a business site had been accessed through a hole cut in the fence sometime overnight in Red Deer County.
- A business in Red Deer County reported that a former employee had stolen multiple tools before leaving. The matter is under investigation.

June 4, 2026

- Police are investigating the complaint of Uttering Threats against a Person which has been occurring in Blackfalds.
- It was reported that someone had cut holes through a fence and tents at a business in Red Deer County. Seacans had been accessed and a bunch of cables had been stolen.

June 5, 2026

- A call was received of a dispute at a bar in Blackfalds. Police attended and spoke to the individuals involved. They separated for the night and no charges were laid.
- Police attended the call of a two-vehicle collision which caused once vehicle to rollover. One female driver was charged for failing to yield to a motor vehicle lawfully in intersection – green light.

June 6, 2026

- It was reported that a garage had been broken into at a residence in Blackfalds, and an E-Bike was stolen.
- A call was received that an unknown male was displaying erratic behaviour in a vehicle with the engine running. Members attended and issued a 24-hour suspension on suspicion of drug use.

June 7, 2026

- Police were advised that the tires of two trucks had been slashed sometime overnight in Blackfalds.
- A call was received of a truck fire in Red Deer County. Police and Fire attended and were able to determine that the truck had been stolen earlier in the day. The owner was notified that it had been found.

June 8, 2026

- Blackfalds RCMP in conjunction with Red Deer GIS, Red Deer CRT, Sylvan Lake GIS, CAD Crime Reduction Team, and the Alberta Emergency Response Team made arrests and suspects involved. A detailed media release is to follow.
- Police conducted a traffic stop on an erratic driver. The female driver provided two breath samples which resulted in “Fail” readings. She was issued an IRS Suspension and the vehicle was towed.
